Travel Directions: Signed off the A303 at signs to Barton Stacey; nearest postcode SO21 3QS.

Terrain: Open land, with multiple areas of hard standing with some small forested areas, few contours and a good path network; with the map cut by two minor roads running north to south.

Warning note: this is a military area – do NOT touch suspicious objects of any kind

Note: Full leg & arm cover required - bring a cagoule & head gear if cold and/or wet

Map: A4 size; scale 1:10,000; partial updates; control descriptions on map only

Course: **1 hour Score;** visit as many controls as possible in the hour

Warning: competitors will be required to cross two minor roads to collect all controls
Penalties for minutes or part minutes over the hour!

Start/ Finish: Near the parking area

Times: Registration: 1200 to 1245 hrs
Punching Mass Start: 1300 hrs
Course Closes: 1430 hrs
