

FINAL DETAILS

Directions and Parking	<p>Please note that our previous access via Ludgershall has just been stopped and is strictly not permitted for this event. Access to the event will be from the north via Herridge Stud farm (SU264546) (steep and well-rutted in part) (signposted from the A346) or past Gammon's farm (SU 278555) (potholed in places but flat) (signposted from Chute Causeway). Parking along a good forest track further south. Cars will be turned before parking to aid departure (see below). No departures before 1230. Please note that the competition area is east of this track and although competitors are not planned to cross it, drivers are to be particularly cautious and to look out for competitors that have become disorientated in the vicinity of the track. The area east of this route in is out of bounds to anyone who has not started their run.</p>

Entries and Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-entry (Seniors: £9; Juniors £4), via www.Fabian4.co.uk closes at midnight on Sunday 2 October • There will be Entry-on-the-Day available (09:30 – 12:00) for all courses until the additional printed maps have been allocated. • Entry-on-the-Day Fees: Adults: £10, less Beginners' Courses (Orange, Yellow, White) £4; Juniors: £4 • If you have competed in three orienteering events registered with British Orienteering and not joined an orienteering club which is a member of British Orienteering, you are not covered by our public liability insurance. To comply with insurance provisions, if you are not a British Orienteering member, please leave your home address contact details at Registration.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Contact details for competitors and their Next-of-Kin are now required to be held at Registration. This is a new requirement and competitors are requested to complete the form that will be provided on arrival or which may be downloaded from the Collingbourne event page on our website. Competitors are asked to comply with this new requirement until a web-based solution is developed in due course. Contact forms will also be held at Registration.																																							
EMIT Electronic Punching	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Those without EMIT cards must hire from Registration: adults £1.50; juniors 50p.• Lost Emit cards will incur a further £40 charge.• Pre-entries who have hired EMIT cards must collect them from Registration.• It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that their card has been correctly activated at the start and that they obtain a correct punch at the control site, including a backup pin mark on the backup card.• Backup cards will be available at Registration – please ensure you have a fresh one if you are using your own card. Only an electronic punch or backup pin mark will be accepted as evidence of having completed the course.• There will be a sample EMIT control beside Registration for those unfamiliar with the system.• All participants MUST download their EMIT card after their run, back in the Assembly Area.																																							
Assembly Area Facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tom and Julie's Burger van will be situated next to Registration along the main forest track.• Portaloos will be provided along the Assembly area track.																																							
Start	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The start is located approx 700m from the Assembly Area along forest tracks.• Participants may start at a time of their own choosing between 10:00 and 12:30.• There will be a -3 minute call-up.• Loose Control Descriptions and Blank Maps will be available in the Start Lanes.• A safety check EMIT record will be taken at the Start.• White & Yellow courses can pick up their maps before the Start line																																							
Finish	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Finish is located approx 250m from Assembly Area along forest tracks.• All participants, even if you did not finish your course, MUST report to the Download Tent in the Assembly Area.																																							
Course Closure	Courses close at 14:30 after which controls will be collected in.

Terrain	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mostly runnable woodland with a good path/track network. There are areas of brambles which impede route choice. Recent felling means there will be some unmarked tracks, parked up vehicles and large log piles.																																							
Map	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The scale is 1:10,000 for all courses with 5m contour intervals.• Maps will be printed by BML on waterproof paper; A4 size for all courses.																																							
Control Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Control Descriptions will be printed on the map: Orange up to Brown courses will have pictorial descriptions; Yellow and White courses will have written ones.• Loose control descriptions on waterproof paper will also be available at the Start; Light Green up to Brown courses will again be pictorial descriptions; Orange, Yellow and White will be written.																																							
Map Memory Course	A free course for younger orienteers will be open from 10:30-12:00 adjacent to the Assembly Area. The course will be a simple map memory exercise using EMIT.																																							
Shadowing	Shadowing younger participants is permitted but not before your run. The shadower must NOT pick up an additional map at the start.																																							
Results	Results will be displayed in the Assembly Area throughout the day. They will also be available as soon as possible after the event on the Sarum website (www.sarumo.org.uk). If written																																							

	results are required, please leave a stamped self-addressed envelope at Registration marked "Results".
Protests	If you have any reason to complain about your course or the event arrangements, then please talk informally with the Organiser in the first instance, who will talk to other officials if necessary. If you feel the need to make an Official Protest, you must do this in writing to the Controller, who will discuss with the Organiser. If they agree with the Protest, the appropriate action will be taken.
Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Other recreational users of the area will mainly include horse riders and dog walkers; there is little evidence of regular mountain bikers. Motorcyclists are not permitted in the wood. Please show due respect, particularly to the horses and dogs, if you meet any of these on your run. Due to the change of access, cars will now traverse the track the north/south track to the west of the competition area. Runners are to pay particular attention if they find themselves unintentionally in vicinity of this vehicle track. • There could be forestry equipment parked in the woods. KEEP CLEAR! • There are a number of log piles in the forest. These are strictly Out of Bounds for safety reasons. Everyone is requested to ensure that children do not climb on these interesting, but dangerous, obstacles. • Whistles are advised to be carried, especially for juniors. • Carrying and/or wearing cagoules could be mandatory if the weather is very bad. In this case a sign will be posted in Assembly and on the route to the start. • If you become lost on the area, think whether you are north or south of the main east/west vehicle track and after you reach it, turn west until you reach the Assembly Area. • If you come to the event alone, we would be grateful if you would leave your named vehicle keys / details at Registration. • First Aid assistance will be based at the Assembly Area. Existing Medical Conditions	Competitors with existing medical conditions are asked to provide a sealed envelope with their name and club on the outside, and the medical condition explained inside plus details of medication and dosage. Spare forms and envelopes will be available at Registration. The envelope will only be opened in an emergency. The envelope is to be handed in to Registration for safe keeping before competitors start their runs.
Conditions / Cancellation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The personal data you give will be used by the event organisers only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results, using contact information in the event of an emergency and as required by British Orienteering insurers. • SARUM Orienteering Club reserve the right to cancel the event in unforeseen circumstances, particularly if weather conditions may endanger participants unnecessarily. In the event of such cancellation, all or part of the entry fees may be retained to cover the cost of expenses already incurred. • If cancellation is necessary, a notice will be posted on the BOF and Sarum websites and pre-entrants contacted through Fabian4.
