FINAL DETAILS

Update: All runners will now use touch free EMIT cards – please go to Registration to get one before you run (free exchange if you already own one)

- Parking & Assembly at Boscombe Down Sports Pavilion SP4 7LP (SU169405)
- Entry-on-the-day while maps last
- EMIT touch-free electronic system (*can use original EMIT cards – please check how to use!*)
- Start 300m from Assembly with Finish in Arena
- Water/ squash available at the Finish; Ultrasport in attendance; no caterer; (*do NOT drink the water in the Pavilion*)
- **Juniors (under 16) must be accompanied by an adult to the Start**
- **Course 7** (12-) – please run in **1st hour** (4-5pm)
- **Course 6** (16-) – **must** be accompanied on their run
- **All runners must wear a bright coloured top** – a condition from the local Council so the public can see us coming.
- All courses (except Cse 7) will have timed road crossings, out & back (**45 seconds allowed each way**). Please take care crossing this busy road and heed the marshals. Also note that there are different controls going out & coming back at this crossing.

Directions and parking

Optimum route: from A345 (Salisbury to Amesbury road) – turn east towards Boscombe Down & Archers Gate, at the roundabout just south of Amesbury – there will be O signs from here (SP4 7LN SU158396). Follow O signs to venue.

Also signed at: SU169409 SP4 7QF - east of the town– follow signs to Boscombe Down; go past the Camp entrance & on, southwards, towards the venue.

Parking is in the Sports Field for cars; larger vehicles/ Camper vans – please park in special site shown on map (near the route to the Start)
Assembly is inside the Pavilion.

Entries

Pre-entry closes on Monday 24th April 2017. Entry-on-the-Day will be available as long as map stocks last

Registration and Fees

There will be registration on the day, until maps run out: 3.30pm – 5.30pm
Entry on the day fees: Seniors - £14; (Seniors on Novice Course - £7); Juniors - £5

	Dogs	Dogs are not allowed in the Main car park as it is Boscombe Down's Sports field. They are also not allowed on the courses. However, if you need to bring your dog, please park in the large vehicle/ overflow car park shown on the map. Please clean up after your dog, particularly since this is private property.		
	Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please take care at the marked crossing point & heed the Marshals; • The area uses many housing estates – look out for random car movement and take particular care when exiting alleyways onto roads; • Wear bright clothing so that pedestrians, in particular, are aware of your approach; • Courses cross many minor roads plus the east/west road leading to the town – the courses have been planned to give you a good line of sight to enable you to cross these roads safely – please be aware of the traffic & take care! • All Juniors under 16, must be accompanied by an adult to the Start; • Runners on Course 6 (16-) must be accompanied by an adult around their course; • Course 7 (12-) has a minor road crossing which will be marshalled – please obey the Marshals' instructions; there will be no time deduction here; • The grassy areas could be rather slippery if damp so take care when running across them; • Lone competitors: if you are travelling alone we would be grateful if you would leave your named keys/details at enquiries; • Runners with a specific medical condition that we should know about in an emergency, should leave these details in a named, sealed envelope with Registration/ First Aid – to be used in the case of emergency & will be destroyed, unopened, after the event. 		
	Terrain	Please do not attempt to cross any fences – courses have been planned to avoid the need for this. We want to use this area again! The area is a mixture of housing/ some shops and open grassy areas.		
	Results	Results will be displayed in the Assembly area throughout the event inside the Pavilion. They will also be available as soon as possible after the event on the Sarum website (www.sarumo.org.uk). Routegadget should also be available as soon as possible after the event.		
	Protests	If you have any reason to complain about your course then please talk informally with the organiser in the first instance, who will talk with other officials if necessary. If you feel the need to make an official protest, you must do this in writing, to the controller who will discuss with the organiser. If they agree with the protest, the appropriate action will be taken.
