### NEW YEAR'S DAY SCORE EVENT - FINAL DETAILS

**Monday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018**

- Venue:** Villages of Morgans Vale, Redlynch and Woodfalls plus Tinney's Firs wood
- Parking:** Assembly and car park at Redlynch Sports and Social Club (*Woodfalls Cross, The Ridge, Woodfalls, Salisbury, Wiltshire, SP5 2LN*) GR **SU 198197** (O/S map 130).
- Map:** 1:5,000; 2.5m contours.
- Courses:** **1 hour Score** (visit as many controls as possible in the hour). 40 controls are located across the competition area. Each control has a point value of 10 points. There are 5 bonus controls worth 20 points; 2 in Tinney's Firs. The bonus controls are not marked on the map. They can be found by reading the map extract that will be attached to a control in the general vicinity. There are some yellow course controls that are not marked on the map. These controls have no point value. Several controls are located in front gardens – permission has been given for access. 10 points will be deducted for each minute or part of a minute if the competitor returns after the one hour point. Juniors under age 16 entering the score event must be accompanied by an adult.
- Yellow course.** A 2.4 Km yellow course has been put in Tinney's Firs with 14 controls and 45m of climb. The course is based on path, fence and stream line features.
- Start/ Finish:** The Score Start is located approx 400m from the car park and is opposite the Post Office. The Yellow Start is on the gate to the field next to the Post Office car park. The Finish for both courses is located on the Redlynch playing fields next to the Assembly car park.
- Times:** Registration: 1135 – 1225; Score Starts: 1200 – 1230; Yellow starts: 1140-1230; Courses close at 1340
- Entry:** Entry on the day only. Seniors £5, Juniors £2.
- E-Cards:** An EMIT card is required to be able to enter and may be hired for £1. Note lost EMIT cards will be charged at £40.
- Dogs:** No dogs permitted in the car park or on the playing fields please. Dogs are however permitted in Tinney's Firs.
- Facilities:** Toilets and showers are located in the Redlynch Sports and Social Club (by kind permission); a First Aid tent will be provided; No refreshments are provided but the Woodfalls Inn is next to the Assembly car park and the Redlynch Sports and Social Club will be open for refreshments also.
- Conditions:** While wet weather shouldn't provide difficulty on the urban part of the course, Tinney's Firs can become muddy in the event of prolonged wet weather. Care should be taken. Goggles must be worn if conditions dictate. Whistles recommended for juniors in Tinney's Firs.

- Terrain:** Controls are positioned on both sides of The Ridge within the villages of Morgans Vale, Redlynch and Woodfalls. Tinney's Firs is mostly runnable and contains a simple path network around it. There is one small pond which, although not deep, should be avoided. Tinney's Firs is frequented by dog walkers. Mountain Bikes are not permitted in the wood.
- Wildlife:** There is no wildlife to cause concern to competitors in Tinney's Firs. A usual post-race check for ticks should be made by competitors.
- Data:** The personal data you give will be used by the event organisers only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries and results and as required by our insurers.
- MTBO:** Competitors should be aware that a MTBO Score Course around villages of Morgans Vale, Redlynch and Woodfalls is also being run from the Redlynch Sports and Social Club between 1130-1400.
