#### FINAL DETAILS

- Assembly at Warminster Town Park Community Centre (BA12 9NQ GR ST874448)
- Parking – by Civic Centre (BA12 8FG) ST872450 or by the Station – please follow red line on map to avoid competition area (same route from the Station).
- Wear bright colours to run, please – a condition of our permissions
- Entry-on-the-day while maps last
- EMIT electronic system
- Start 75m & Finish 130m from Assembly
- No water provided – please bring your own
- No caterer - café in the Park close by plus Morrisons across the road
- **Juniors (cse 6/7) must be accompanied by an adult on their course**
- Please use crossings in the centre of the town – marked on maps
- Emergency phone number at the top of the map in case of any emergency

<p><b>Directions and parking</b></p>	<p>The A360 circles the town; from this, take any road towards the town centre and head for a Town Car park. The two main ones seem to be near the Civic Centre (BA12 8FG GR ST872450) or the Station (the Civic Centre one is closest)</p> <p>Parking in the Town Car Parks is free on Sundays currently: the Civic Centre one is preferred and very close to the Park (Note: next door Morrisons charge) – walk through Morrisons Car park to reach the Town Park; if using the Car Park near the Station, please follow red line on map to avoid the Competition area, please; turn south at the traffic lights to get to the Park.</p>

<p><b>Entries</b></p>	<p>Pre-entry closes on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2018. Entry-on-the-Day will be available as long as map stocks last There are also maps for Novice runners</p>
<p><b>Registration and Fees</b></p>	<p>There will be registration on the day, until maps run out: 11.00am – 13.00pm          Entry on the day fees: Seniors - £12; (Seniors on Novice Course - £5); Juniors - £4          Electronic punching: Emit Cards to hire: Seniors: £1.50; Juniors: 50p (lost cards £55.00)</p>



<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs are allowed under control in the Park only – not in the Town. There are cattle in a field adjacent to all courses. Please clean up after your dog,
<b>Safety</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is an emergency phone number at the top of the maps in case of emergencies. This phone will be with the Organiser.</li> <li>• Please use only <b>the marked crossing points</b> in the centre of the town - traffic can be fast; courses have been designed to facilitate this</li> <li>• Please wear <b>bright colours</b> to run so that pedestrians can see you (this is a condition of our permissions)</li> <li>• There will be traffic and pedestrians around the town centre - please be courteous &amp; careful around this area</li> <li>• Take extra care going around corners and crossing roads, particularly across any entrances into the Supermarkets</li> <li>• <b>All Juniors (16 &amp; under) must be accompanied by an adult on their courses, please, unless agreed otherwise with the Organiser.</b> Juniors are aged under 16 on this course, not under 21 as defined by BOF.</li> <li>• All courses cross the grassy slopes - these could be very slippery so take care when running down them</li> <li>• The central area of the map is a Nature Park – some fields are marked as out of bounds as they may have cattle in them – <b>please obey the OOB markings</b></li> <li>• There are various churches around the central area of the Town – please be polite &amp; respectful going passed them</li> <li>• The River Wylye runs through the centre of the area and should only be crossed at bridged points – do NOT wade through the river!</li> <li>• Fences marked as uncrossable (normally barbed wire) should not be crossed – they usually denote private land with livestock</li> <li>• Lone competitors: if you are travelling alone we would be grateful if you would leave your named keys/details at enquiries.</li> </ul>
<b>Terrain</b>	<p>Please do not attempt to cross any wire fences – courses have been planned to encourage runners to use the crossings points. We want to use this area again!</p> <p>The area is a mixture of shopping/ housing and parkland with some open fields with steep grassy banks. There is a steep valley through the middle of the map. The course will not go through any areas of undergrowth.</p>
<b>Results</b>	Results will be displayed in the Assembly area throughout the event inside the Community Centre. They will also be available as soon as possible after the event on the Sarum website ( <a href="http://www.sarumo.org.uk">www.sarumo.org.uk</a> ). Splitsbrowser will also be available after the event.
<b>Protests</b>	If you have any reason to complain about your course then please talk informally with the organiser in the first instance, who will talk with other officials if necessary. If you feel the need to make an official protest, you must do this in writing, to the controller who will discuss with the organiser. If they agree with the protest, the appropriate action will be taken.
<b>Conditions/ cancellation</b>	<p>The personal data you give will be used by the event organisers only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results and as required by our insurers.</p> <p>In the event of cancellation, all or part of the entry fees may be retained to cover the cost of expenses already incurred. In the unlikely event of cancellation, a notice will be posted on the BOF and Sarum websites. Pre- entries will not be returned from receipt of these details.</p> <p><b>All competitors run at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.</b></p>
