- Assembly:** The Boot Inn, High Street, Tisbury SP3 6PS (GR ST944296) – in the marquee behind the pub
- Travel/Parking:** Head for the village of Tisbury, about 30 minutes west of Salisbury. In the Village, Assembly is behind the Boot Pub in the Marquee. There is no parking at the Pub. Park at the Nadder Sports Centre ([SP3 6HJ](#)) & walk straight down to the High Street - turn left for the Pub, half way up the High Street.
- Courses:** **Score course - 23 controls including 5 'dumbbells'**  
There will be 5 pairs of controls joined by a line which, when punched consecutively, with no other controls in between, will score 20 extra points. Otherwise they will just score their value like all other controls. Values on the map. Time penalties apply - details at the event. Punching start near the Pub.  
**All register with the Start team before they run, please.**  
Hired SI dibbers can be picked up at Download in the marquee behind the Pub.  
**All welcome, but juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult (over18)**

- Course closes:** 20.15pm
- Electronic system:** SIAC enabled controls
