Flyer amended due to change in the Parking (1st Feb 2025):

Venue: Great Ridge – ST 927345 – off the A303 east of Chicklade (W3W: electrode.overlook.books)
Take care turning off the A303 – a very fast road
Linear Parking for cars on the Forest entrance ride ; Mini buses and camper vans should expect to park at the Barn on the entrance track and then walk about 700 metres up to the wood. Parking is next to Assembly.
The Start will be about 200m from Assembly; the Finish about 250m away from Assembly.
The Exit is back out of the same gateway so **all are asked to arrive by 12.00 and no departures until 12.15, please.**

Terrain: Mixed woodland with a good network of paths along a chalk ridge.

Map: Updated in 2022 by Mapworks with minor updates for the event due to ongoing Forestry work, as it is a working Forest .

Map Scales: Elite classes :1:15,000; Courses 13,14,17,18,19 will be 1:7500; all other courses: 1:10,000 ; 5m contours

Registration: Online entries to [RaceSignUp](https://www.racesignup.com) before **Sunday March 2nd 2025**. Colour coded courses entries until Thursday 6th March. Final details and results will be available on-line via [RaceSignup](https://www.racesignup.com). Entry enquiries fixtures@sarumo.co.uk

To be competitive for the Southern Championships, you must enter the age class matching your age and sex or 'run up'. Eligibility also requires that you are a member of British Orienteering and a member of one of the Southern Regional Associations: SWOA:SCOA:SEOA. Trophies and other prizes are only awarded to the highest categories (Elite, Long or A) of each age class.

Fees: *Early bird entry until 16th February 2025 23.59 :* Seniors £16; Junior/ Students/ Novice £9; Non BOF £18
From 17th Feb until 2nd March 2025 23.59: Seniors £18; Junior/Students/Novice £10; Non BOF £20 .
Late entry(non-competitive) 3rd - 6th March 23.59: Seniors £20; Juniors/Students/ Novice £11; Non BOF £22
Novice senior (Orange/Yellow/White courses) (Juniors are under 21 on 31st December 2025)
Very limited Colour coded entry on the day (White/Yellow/ Orange, Light Green) – dependent on Map numbers - available up to 11.30 (entry via Race Sign up preferred, otherwise Cash only, please)
Be sure to have renewed your BOF membership to avoid the Non BOF premium!

Assembly opens: 09.30 ; Hired dibbers will be available next to Download

Starts: 10.00 – 13.00 You can choose to start: VE(very early); E(early); M(middle); L(late); VL(very late) or A (any). Actual Start times will be seeded and published on the RaceSign Up webpage after the Entry closing date. It is a timed Start for all competitive courses.
Courses close at 15.00

Electronic Punching: The event will be using SI Dibbers on all courses. Controls will be SIAC enabled.
SIAC SI hire: £2.00 (£65 for any lost dibbers) Courses 1&2 have more than 30 controls;
Course 3 has 29 controls – please make sure you have a dibber that can record that many controls
It will be a timed Start and a **Punching Finish**

There will not be a String course
